Judging: Dancers will be judged according to the techniques of the RSOBHD. Judge's decision shall be final. There will be no access to the judge's score sheets. In the event of a protest, a \$35.00 non-refundable fee must accompany a written complaint and be submitted to the organizers the same day as the competition.

We are happy to announce that the Fredericton Highland Dance Association will host a demonstration event in conjunction with the Kate Gaddess Memorial Dance Competition

This is open to any new dancers ages three to ten that are not competing but would like to participate. The dances will be performed on stage, in front of the judge but will not be adjudicated. Dancers will receive a participation ribbon – there will not be awards. This is a wonderful opportunity to introduce young dancers to competitive highland dancing. It is also an opportunity for parents and dancers to 'learn the ropes' without the pressure of competition.

Dancers can register for the individual dances that they know - 16 Pas de Basques, Pas de Basques and Highcuts, and the Highland Fling.

Dancers can perform in a white shirt/blouse, white knee socks, ghillies and a kiltie. Your dance teacher should be able to help with costuming.

We would like dancers to be at the venue for 9:30 am. We will have them perform immediately after the primary competitive dancers complete their dances. There is no fee to enter this event.
