- 2. Dancers will be judged according to the techniques of the R.S.O.B.H.D.
- 3. Judges decision is final. No communication can be entered into between teachers, parents and dancers with the judge.
- 4. Age of competitor to be determined as of Saturday January 20, 2024
- 5. Categories will be decided based on the number of entries.
- 6. Adult age groups will be offered in all categories if numbers warrant
- 7. All dancers must have a valid 2024 RSOBHD Card on the day of the competition. There will be a \$10 penalty without your card.
- 8. Numbers can be picked up at the registration desk. RSOBHD cards to be provided at this time.

9. All complaints must be lodged in writing and accompanied by a \$25.00 processing fee.
